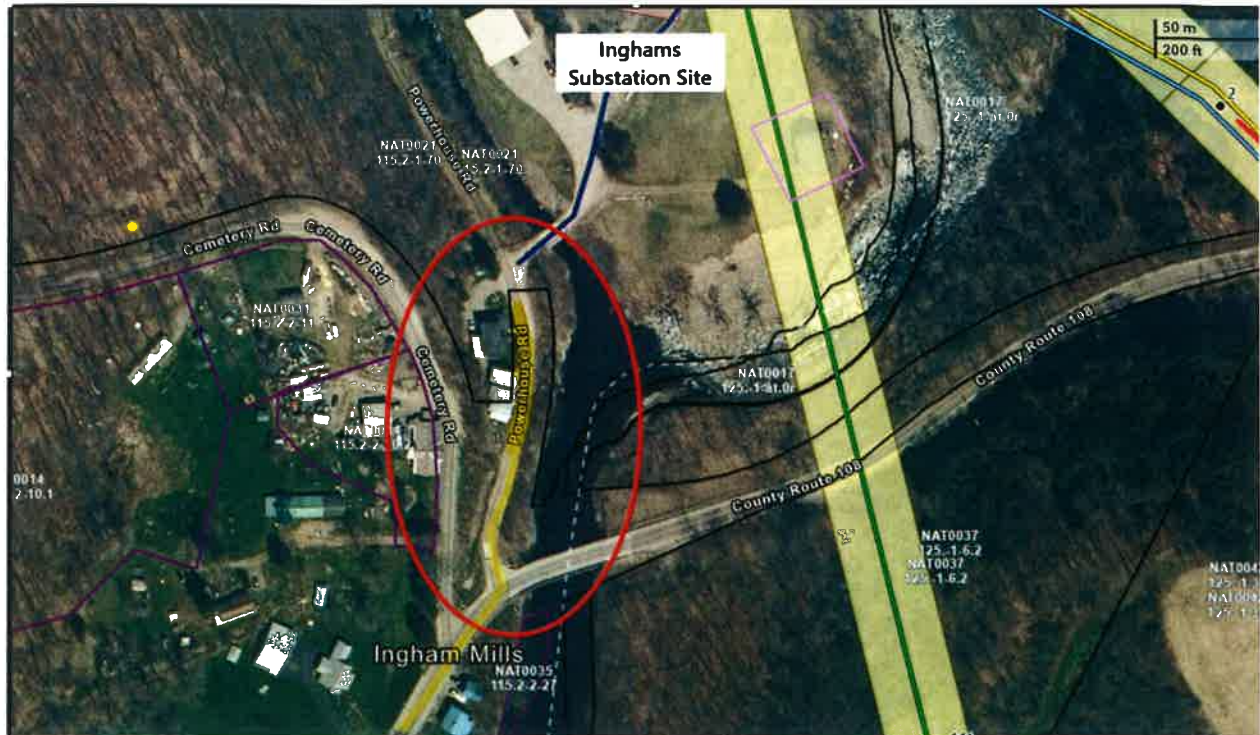
Subject: 01130 - NatGrid - Haul Routes - Town of Manheim

Hello Ken,

My name is Pauline Pangilinan and I am Canacre's Planner supporting National Grid's Inghams to Rotterdam Transmission Rebuild Project. The Town Clerk has advised us to reach out to you.

Construction is getting underway on Segment 6 of the project between National Grid's Inghams Substation and St. Johnsville Substation. Segment 6 construction activities at the Inghams Substation site are expected to take place between June and November 2026. Our construction team recently had to modify their haul route to access the Inghams Substation site at Powerhouse Rd. coming west off Ingham-Mills Rd. Please note, construction activities related to the Article VII circuits Inghams-Meco and Inghams-Stoner (Segments 1 & 4) are anticipated to start in Spring 2027 and continue through 2028. At which time, construction crews will again use Powerhouse Rd to access the Inghams Substation site.

I'm reaching out to provide you with a map of the access to the substation site. Crews will travel from the laydown yard in West St. Johnsville along State Route 5, north along Snells Bush Rd, and east on Inghams Mills Rd. Powerhouse Rd is the only town road to be utilized during construction of Segment 6. Crews will monitor the road for any damages and wear, restoring the surface to its original condition or better upon completion of construction.



We have reached out separately to Herkimer County regarding the route affecting Snells Bush Rd and Inghams Mills Rd.

Thank you for your assistance and I look forward to the opportunity to answer any questions the Town may have about use of Powerhouse Rd.

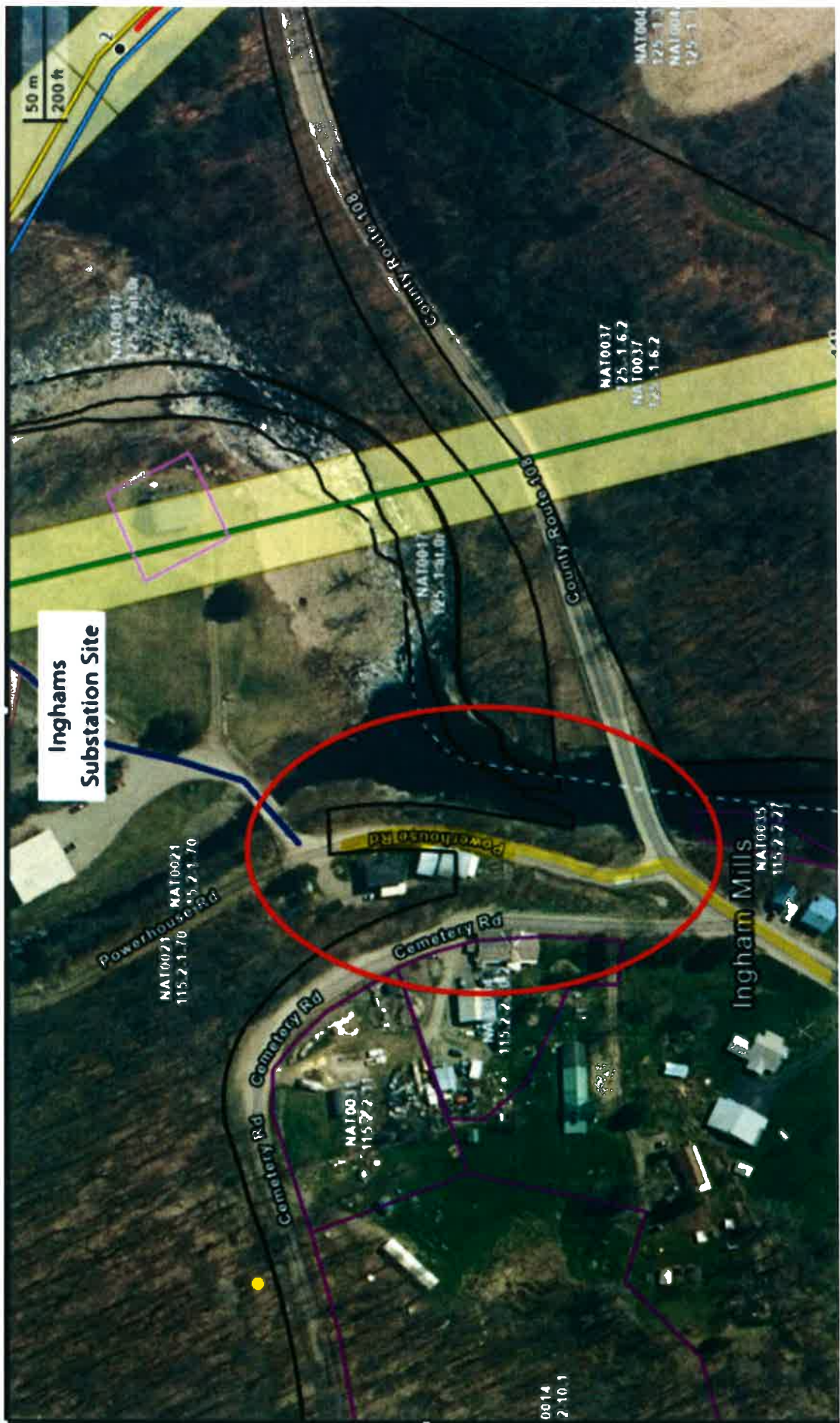

The following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED, That the Adirondack Electric Power Corporation
(a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of New
York, for the purpose, among other things, of manufacturing, pro-
ducing, purchasing, selling, transmitting and dealing in electricity
or the use of electricity for light, heat and power; the carrying
on of the business of lighting by electricity and using it for
heat and power in cities, towns and villages within this State, and
the streets, avenues, public parks and places thereof, and
public and private buildings therein), its successors and assigns,
may lay, erect, construct and maintain suitable wires and other
conductors over and across the several highways of said Town for
conducting and distributing electricity therein, and beyond the
limits thereof, or for producing light, heat and power, and that
said Company, its successors and assigns, may at all times, conduct,
transmit and distribute electricity for light, heat and power by the

means and in the manner aforesaid, provided always and this consent is given by said municipal authority subject at all times to the following conditions and regulations:

FIRST: The wires or over-head conductors shall be strung and maintained from pole to pole, or other fixture, at least twenty-five feet above ground; but, in case such wires or other conductors shall from breakage or other cause become out of proper position, the same shall be repaired and replaced without delay.

SECOND: The said poles and wires shall be so constructed and placed as not to interfere with the use of or in any way encroach upon any of the traveled portion of the highway.

THIRD: That at all places where said wires cross over the highway, the same shall be properly cradled.

FOURTH: That the said poles shall be located at such a place or places and in such a manner as shall be approved by the Superintendent of Highways of said Town. He shall have the right and authority to cause the location of any pole which interferes with the use of said highway or highways for public purposes or with the reasonable convenience and access of the residents along the same to be re-located in such reasonable place and manner as not to interfere with the access to said highway by the residents and dwellers thereon or by the public.

FIFTH: Said Adirondack Electric Power Corporation, its successors and assigns, shall assume responsibility for all damage caused to any person whatsoever, by reason of the erection and maintenance of said poles, wires and transmission lines along, upon or across said highways, and shall indemnify and save harmless the said Town of Manheim, its Boards, officers, agents and servants

from and against all damage, costs, expenses and charges of every nature, by reason of or in consequence of any omission or negligent act on the part of the said Adirondack Electric Power Corporation, its officers, agents, servants or employees to any person whatsoever.

The undersigned Supervisor, Town Clerk and Justices of the Peace of the Town of Manheim aforesaid hereby certify that at the said meeting the foregoing resolution was duly adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Manheim.
